

THIS BIBLIOGRAPHY OF PUBLICATIONS issued during 1983 was compiled at the National Archives and Records Administration and is based on the holdings in the National Archives Library. Like its predecessors, this bibliography is a selected listing of references to professional literature published in the United States and other countries, arranged broadly by subject according to the outline below.

"Writings on Archives . . ." has been compiled by the National Archives since 1942, and published in the *American Archivist* from 1943 to 1980, with the 1978 annual compilation appearing in 1980 (vol. 43). A combined listing for 1979-1982 was published by the National Archives in 1985.

The style used in this bibliography varies with the styles found in the individual publications. Therefore there are some inconsistencies in the placement of elements within entries and in punctuation.

About the compiler: Patricia A. Andrews is the Director of the Central Information Division at the National Archives and Records Administration. She served as bibliography editor for the *American Archivist* from 1967 to 1974 and was one of the compilers of *Writings on Archives . . . 1979-1982*, published by the National Archives in 1985.

Archives & Manuscripts: Law, by Gary M. Peterson and Trudy Huskamp Peterson, focuses on basic legal issues in archives. In presenting the legal questions that confront archivists, the authors describe major types of laws governing archives and discuss reasonable means of analyzing and resolving legal issues. The first five chapters focus on the legal aspect of common archival functions: the accession, donation, and receipt of materials; the concepts and administration of access policy; and the legal implications of reference service. The last three chapters deal with special topics including a discussion of copyright law, a review of the legal standards for admissibility of documents in evidence, a discussion of the problems of replevin, advice on working with a lawyer, and a description of the process of litigation. Facilities and records of the **Territorial Archives of American Samoa** were damaged by a fire in the government Administration Building on 29 November 1985. The fire, which started in the Budget and Planning Office, spread rapidly to other areas of the building including the Office of Archives and Records Management. Firefighters were unable to save the affected offices but were successful in preventing the fire's spread to the main section of the building, which houses the governor's office and other departments.

In the aftermath, archives staff found that all office equipment and furnishings, including microfilm readers and a camera, were destroyed. Office administrative files survived with only slight charring. The most important archival collection in the office was the Governor's Office records from the 1960s

and 1970s. Approximately 70 percent of the 320 cubic feet survived the fire, although they were water-soaked. The archives established a restoration facility in the territory's Convention Center. After moving the damaged files to that location, the worst soaked records were repacked and placed into freezers to prevent mold growth, and work began on drying, refoldering, and reboxing remaining records. The Treasurer's Office, which also suffered water damage to records, shared the restoration facility with the archives. As those records were dried, they were either returned to the treasurer's custody or placed with the records center facility operated by the Territorial Archives.

Ironically, the fire occurred shortly before the planned move of the archives to a newly-renovated facility. The Office of Archives and Records Management

had been established in 1984 with statutory responsibilities assigned by public law. At that time, it replaced a several-year-old Records Office that lacked a statutory base, scheduling authority, or an archival component. After its establishment, the office occupied temporary facilities in the Administration Building and in three other locations. Lack of space, inadequate environmental conditions, and the danger of fire had led to plans to move the office out of these quarters into a fireproof building across the street from the legislature. The building was to become available in December; the archives was to occupy it by March 1986 upon completion of upgrading of the air conditioning system, improvements in electrical wiring, installation of heat and smoke detectors, and the erection of standard steel shelving.

The archives will move to the renovated building when all the necessary work has been completed. At that time, the building will house the archives and records center as well as microfilming and administrative operations.

An interesting case of possible replevin emerged in Concord, New Hampshire, in March 1986 when the sale of an original printing of the Declaration of Independence was postponed until a determination could be made whether the document belonged to the state of **New Hampshire** or to the Society of the Cincinnati. The copy, which had been in the attic of the historic Gilman-Ladd House in Exeter, New Hampshire, for many years, was to be auctioned by Sotheby's on behalf of the Society of Cincinnati to provide funds for their philanthropic endeavors and for the restoration and refurbishing of the society's headquarters in Exeter.

The document was brought to the attention of the state by Sotheby's, who

was acting on behalf of the society. The society voluntarily withdrew the document after the state raised questions about the ownership. The basis for this uncertainty is a small piece of paper found with the declaration and signed with the notation "received, July 16, 1776," which appears to be in the handwriting of Ebenezer Thompson, the secretary of state for New Hampshire at that time.

Attorneys for the state argued that an additional indication that the document belongs to the state is that in the eighteenth century the family that owned the home where this document was found included many members who served in prominent government posts.

On 26 April the State Attorney General Stephen Merrill demanded the return of the document. Merrill said the state was negotiating with the society for the permanent return of the document, but added that the state would take legal action if negotiations failed.

The **J. Walter Thompson Company Archives** has changed its access policy and opened its extensive collection of microfilmed research studies. The records, which date from the 1920s to the early 1940s, include thousands of consumer surveys, demographic studies of cities and towns across the United States as well as European and Latin American countries, and media studies. An index by client and date, and a listing of the contents of every reel, including the title and date of each report, is available in the archives. J. Walter Thompson Company was famous for its research department, first established in 1915 and headed for many years by Paul Cherington, a well-known marketing pioneer and first president of the American Marketing Association. 

The **Grail Movement, Loveland, Ohio**, opened its archives to researchers on 1 January 1986. The work of arranging the collection (350 linear feet) was made possible by a grant from the National Endowment for the Humanities in 1984-1985. The Grail is a small worldwide movement of women involved in social justice and women's issues, international understanding, and spiritual search.

Roman Catholic in origin, the Grail now includes women of other traditions in its membership. The records, which date from the 1940s to the present, document the development of the lay apostolate in the Roman Catholic church; the role of women in church and society; social justice issues; feminist programs and perspectives; and international concerns, programs, and exchange. 




Appraising the Records of Modern Science and Technology: A Guide, by Joan K. Haas, Helen Willa Samuels, and Barbara Trippel Simmons, encourages archivists to collect more actively in the scientific and technological areas. In order to assist archivists in appraising these records, the authors have structured the *Guide* around descriptions of the scientific and technological activities of scientists and engineers. Each activity, and the records documenting it, is described, followed by discussions of appraisal considerations and examples. In addition, the *Guide* offers recommendations on collecting, arrangement and description, and developing retention guidelines for records in this field. The manual also includes: extended sections on grant and contract records, data, journal articles and technical reports, and patents; a list of scientific and technological discipline history center; a list of selected readings; and an index. The *Guide* is available for \$7 to SAA members, and \$9 to others.



Manuscripts: The First Twenty Years is a 450-page illustrated anthology consisting of more than fifty articles first published in the Manuscript Society's journal from 1948 to 1968. THE AMERICAN ARCHIVIST: EDITORIAL POLICY

The *American Archivist* is the quarterly journal of the Society of American Archivists. In its articles it seeks to reflect the thinking of archivists about trends and major issues in archival philosophy and theory and about the evolution of the archival profession in North America. Its departments are intended to document developments and events relating to archival practice here and abroad.

Society members and those who share the professional interests of the Society are invited to submit manuscripts for consideration. For publication as full length articles, analytical and critical expositions based on original research about subjects of broad interest are preferred. Accounts of innovative methods or techniques are appropriate for the Shorter Features department. Suggestions for submissions to News Notes appear under the department heading. Illustrations are welcome and encouraged in all parts of the journal.

Letters to the editor are welcome when they include pertinent and constructive comments or criticisms of materials recently published in the *American Archivist* or observations on other topics of interest to the profession. They should not exceed 400 words. They will be printed in The Forum with minimal editing. Book reviews will also be printed as received, with minimal editing primarily to conform to our style manual.

Procedures

Manuscripts received by the editor are submitted (without the author's name) to qualified readers for objective appraisal. Upon receiving the readers' reports, the editor informs the author whether the article is accepted, rejected, or returned with suggestions for revision. If an article is accepted, the author will be requested to submit a vita to the editor, which will be used to prepare a brief biographical sketch to accompany the published article. An edited copy of an accepted manuscript will be sent to the author. Authors who object to any of the editing should notify the editor promptly. One set of galley proofs will also be sent to the author for correction of printer's errors only. No substantive changes in the text will be made on galleys.

Ten tear-sheets of each paper published will be provided to the author without charge. Additional reprints may be ordered with a form sent to the author with his galley proofs.

Manuscript Requirements

Manuscripts should be submitted in English, typed double-spaced throughout (including footnotes at the end of the text) on white bond paper 8½ x 11 inches in size. If possible, four copies of the manuscript should be submitted. All pages should be numbered. The author's name and address should appear only on the title page, which should be separate from the main text of the manuscript. Full-length articles should not exceed 5,000 words and should be accompanied by a 100-word abstract. If the article is selected for publication, the abstract will be published as well. Articles submitted for Shorter Features should not exceed 1,000 words; no abstract is required for Shorter Features.

Photographs should be 8 by 10 inch glossy prints. Other illustrations should be professionally drawn to a scale about twice the size of the final copy to be printed. Illustrations furnished by authors will be returned to them on request.

Editors of the *American Archivist* use the University of Chicago *Manual of Style*, 13th edition, as the standard for style, including footnote format, and *Webster's New International Dictionary of the English Language*, 3d edition (G. & C. Merriam Co.) for spelling and punctuation. Authors' variations from these standards should be minimal and purposeful.

Terms having special meanings for members of the profession should conform to the definitions in "A Basic Glossary for Archivists, Manuscript Curators, and Records Managers," *American Archivist* 37 (July 1974):415-33.


