Writings for Archivists, 1990

Editor's note: This bibliography of books and articles related to archives published during 1990 is, like its 1988 and 1989 predecessors, derived fully from the work of the staff of the National Archives Library and its Archives Library Information Center (ALIC). They drew the citations from the library's own holdings and from extensive online bibliographic searching. The editorial staff of the *American Archivist* again received the ALIC product in the form of a Pro-Cite database and manipulated it to produce this published bibliography. This year's editorial process differed from the previous years' in two important respects:

- This bibliography is much more selective than the previous two (a policy necessitated by the increased efficacy of the ALIC staff, who identified nearly 50 percent more entries than the previous year). Annual reports, brief news articles (except those whose enduring value seemed exceptional), brochures, and most non-English language articles were excluded.
- This year's bibliography is arranged by topical categories. The classification scheme is based on one used by Richard Cox in his *Archives and Manuscripts Administration: A Basic Annotated Bibliography* (American Association for State and Local History, 1989) and was implemented by David Klaassen, Kevin Corbitt, and Karen Strauss of the University of Minnesota. It represents a break with the categories employed in the 1943-1980 bibliographies, which were judged to be no longer appropriate for representing the range of contemporary professional archival literature. The author index and cross-references to related categories and citations will ease the user's adjustment to the idiosyncrasies of a new classification system.
