This bibliography of books and articles related to archives published during 1991 is, like its predecessors, derived fully from the work of the staff of the National Archives Library and its Archives Library Information Center (ALIC). They drew the citations from the library's own holdings and from extensive online bibliographic searching. The National Archives once again provided the ALIC product to the *American Archivist* in the form of a Pro-Cite database which was manipulated to produce this published bibliography. On the recommendation of the journal's editor, this year's bibliography does not include descriptions of archival holdings. Annual reports, brief news articles (except those whose enduring value seemed exceptional), brochures, and most non-English language articles were excluded as well.
